HOW TO TEST YOUR SMOKE ALARMS

Test an alarm by waving a stick of incense or smouldering piece of cotton string under it. It should sound after 60 seconds. To silence the alarm after an alarm test, fan a newspaper directly underneath for 60 seconds. Pressing the "TEST" button may not tell you that the unit is working.

Landlords:

According to the Residential Tenancies Branch, a Tenant can be evicted for tampering with a smoke alarm.

Daycare & Residential Care:

Smoke alarms are required to be interconnected.

REMINDER: As per the Manitoba Fire Code, maintenance inspections are required annually. Battery operated smoke alarms should have the battery replaced semi-annually.
