 - (A) REQUEST FOR GIFT-IN-KIND CONTRIBUTION UNITED COMMERCIAL TRAVELERS' AIRSHOW

City Manager recommends that the United Commercial Travelers' request for access to the City of Brandon's insurance and a gift in kind contribution in the amount of \$6,782 for the staging of the Westman Air Show, May 26th and 27th, 2007 at McGill Airfield be approved.

(B) COMMONWEALTH AIR TRAINING PLAN MUSEUM – RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT TO ACCESS CANADA/MANITOBA INFRASTRUCTURE FUNDING

City Manager recommends that the City of Brandon support the Commonwealth Air Training Plan Museum's submission to the Canada/Manitoba Infrastructure Program for funding in the amount of 1.3 million dollars and deem this project to be a high priority for the community.

and further that approval of the designs and locations of identification signs for said subdivision is in accordance with the designs and maps attached to the report of the Planning Division of Development Services dated January 10^{th} , 2007.

(D) PROPOSAL TO SUBDIVIDE 2001 VICTORIA AVENUE EAST (SHAPE FOODS INC.)
