D. EMERGENCY FUNDING FOR OVERLAND FLOODING

That the following be submitted to the Federation of Canadian Municipalities as an emergency resolution for consideration at its 2007 Annual Conference:

WHEREAS unexpected and uncontrollable overland flooding due to acts of nature continues to devastate many Canadians;

AND WHEREAS the level of such devastation is well beyond the ability of the affected Canadians to cope and contend with the effects of such flooding;

AND WHEREAS Provincial and Municipal Governments are limited in their means to address such hardships and assist the victims of such flood ravaged areas;

AND WHEREAS the Federal Government's Disaster Financial Assistance Arrangements currently denies any assistance to many affected Canadians when such overland flooding causes sewer back-up in residential homes;

AND WHEREAS the majority of these affected Canadians do not have the financial means to resume a normal home life after such overland flooding;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Federal Government amend its Disaster Financial Assistance Arrangements policy on emergency funding that results in sewer back-up in a significant number of residences in areas affected by overland flooding in order to adequately and urgently compensate the affected residents.
