(A) EXTENSION OF CITY OF BRANDON STATE OF LOCAL EMERGENCY

WHEREAS due to the rise in the Assiniboine River level, the Council of the City of Brandon, at its meeting held May 8, 2011, declared a state of local emergency in the City of Brandon from May 8, 2011 to May 21, 2011;

AND WHEREAS it is expected that the level of the river will remain high and will require vigilance by the City of Brandon beyond May 21, 2011;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT in accordance Sub-section 11(5) of The Emergency Measures Act, application be made to The Honourable Steve Ashton, Minister responsible for Emergency Measures for an extension to the state of local emergency in the City of Brandon from May 22, 2011 to June 4, 2011.

- <u>Note</u>: Brian Kayes, the City's Emergency Coordinator, will be briefing City Council on the current high water situation.
- (B) CANCELLATION OF PENALTIES ON EVACUEE PROPERTY TAXES

That penalties imposed on 2011 property taxes outstanding for the period up to and including July 31, 2011 for those evacuated properties from 4th to 26th Streets between the Canadian Pacific right-of-way and the river and those properties within the Corral Centre and the Paddock be hereby cancelled whereby such cancellation shall also apply to any other properties deemed eligible by the City Manager.
