Contract Settlement - Canadian Union of Public Employees, Local 69

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the recent negotiations with the Canadian Union of Public Employees, Local 69.

Councillor McCrae called the meeting to order as the attendance of the Chair was unavoidably delayed.

# Councillor Isleifson

That the Committee resolve into closed session. Carried.

Mrs. Fifi presented a summary of the negotiations and advised that this was expected to be ratified by the membership on April 14, 2011 as per the Memorandum of Settlement. The Committee members requested clarity on some issues related to the proposed settlement.

Highlights of the negotiated settlement include:

- Salary increases:
  - 2.0% on January 1, 2011
  - 2.0% on January 1, 2012
  - 2.0% on January 1, 2013
- Adjust salaries for classification of Building Inspector/Plumbing Inspector
- Adjust salaries for classification of Community Planner
- Adjust salaries for classification of Tradesworker Level 3
- Establish tool allowance of \$30/month for specific positions
- Enhance safety boot allowance for temporary employees with recognized seniority
- Increase pay for leadhand responsibilities to \$1/hr.
- Establish pay classification for permanent leadhand assignments in specific sections
- Establish provision for temporary employees to bank a maximum of overtime hours
- General clean-up of clauses and letters of understanding
- Three year contract set to expire December 31, 2013

#### Councillor Isliefson

That the proposed settlement as presented be recommended to City Council as follows:

"That the City of Brandon enter into a three (3) year agreement with the Canadian Union of Public Employees for the period January 1, 2011 to December 31, 2013 as per the Memorandum of Settlement whereby wages shall be increased 2.0% on January 1, 2011, 2.0% on January 1, 2012, and 2.0% on January 1, 2013." Carried Unanimously.
