

Slime Recipe for Easter Bunny Slime

Slime

Slime Supplies

- Elmer's Glue
- Food Colouring
- Contact Solution
- Baking Soda
- Mixing spoon

* you will need 2 tablespoons of water

1. Get a bowl to mix your slime ingredients in.
2. Pour 6 oz of Elmer's white glue into the bowl (take off glue cap and pour until glue doesn't come out anymore).
3. Add in 2 tablespoons of water and mix. Note – if you want the slime to be stretchier, you can add another tablespoon of water.
4. Add in ½ teaspoon of baking soda, food colouring and mix.
5. **SLOWLY** add in 1 tablespoon of contact lens solution. Take this step as slowly as possible so you do not over activate the slime (which makes the slime harder and not as stretchy). Only add in as much as you need for the slime to pull away from the bowl.
6. Take the slime out of the bowl and knead for 5-10 minutes. The slime will be very sticky still at this point. That's normal! If you still find it too sticky after using all of the contact solution, add some lotion to your hands and then knead some more.
7. Have fun with you slime 😊



How to Make Bunny Jars

Now we'll walk you through how to make the bunny jars. You can use these bunny jars to hold your slime and the slime should last at least one week. Just make sure the jar is air tight.

Bunny Jar Supplies

- Small Jars
- Googly Eyes
- Pipe Cleaners
- Pom Pom
- Foam in white and yellow
- Glue Dots



Steps to Make Bunny Jars

1. First add your slime into your jars.
2. Then twist 3 pipe cleaners around each other in the center. Glue this to the jar.
3. Glue on googly eyes and a pom pom for the nose.
4. Cut out two ears and inner ear pieces from the foam. The foam will allow the ears to stand up on their own. We used white for the outer ears and yellow for the inner ears.
5. Then glue the ears to the back of the lid of the jar.
