Vulnerable Persons: A person who because of their age, a disability, or other circumstances, whether temporary or permanent, (a) are in a position of dependence on others; or (b) are otherwise at a greater risk than the general population of being harmed by a person in a position of authority or trust relative to them.

The Police Information Check (PIC) will include the following information as it exists on the date of the search:

- Confirmation of declared criminal convictions from CPIC and/or local databases
- Summary convictions for 5 years, when identified by check of local Police service databases
- Findings of Guilt under the Youth Criminal Justice Act within the applicable disclosure period
- Outstanding entries such as Charges, Warrants, Judicial Orders, Peace Bonds, Probation Orders, and Prohibition Orders
- Absolute Discharges and Conditional Discharges within the applicable disclosure period (1 year for Absolute, 3 years for Conditional)

The Police Vulnerable Sector Check (PVSC) will include all of the above and the following information as it exists on the date of the search:

- All Record Suspensions or Pardons as authorized for release by the Minister of Public Safety and Emergency Preparedness
- In exceptional cases, non-conviction information (when it meets the Exceptional Disclosure Assessment) including but not limited to, Stayed, Withdrawn, Dismissed, and Not Criminally Responsible by Reason of Mental Disorder may be disclosed

The Brandon Police Service reserves the right to refuse to complete a Police Information Check/Police Vulnerable Sector Check.
